



WARNINGS

- Handle with care.

PRECAUTIONS

PRODUCT INFORMATION

- **LAST CALL™ F.C.M.** is effective against False Codling Moth males (*Cryptophlebia leucotreta*).
- It contains an attractant and insecticide which attract False Codling Moth with pheromone to the droplet where they mate with the droplet and come into contact with a lethal dose of permethrin. As a targeted chemical application, it attracts the pest to the chemical and avoids affecting any biological control agents. It reduces the amount of chemical needed per hectare to control the pest and there is no spray drift.
- **LAST CALL™ F.C.M.** is non-phytotoxic for crops.
- **LAST CALL™ F.C.M.** is safe to adult and immature stages of beneficial insects, unless through accidental contact.
- When used as directed, no unwanted residues in or on the harvested crop will occur.
- There is no re-entry interval with the use of **LAST CALL™ F.C.M.**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: (USE ONLY AS DIRECTED)

COMPATIBILITY

LAST CALL™ F.C.M. is not mixable with insecticides or fungicides.

The product is applied by hand using a dispenser pre-calibrated to deliver 50 micro liter drops. Depending on the pest pressure apply between 2 000 – 4 000 drops per hectare, giving a dosage of 100 – 200 grams of product per hectare.

The disposable dispenser consist of the trigger device and the disposable cartridge containing the ready to use **LAST CALL™ F.C.M.** formulation. Prepare the dispenser using the following steps:

- Connect the trigger mechanism and the product containing cylinder. Push the two parts together to break the seal. The two parts are now permanently coupled.
- With the thumb, push the plunger till a drop of grease appears at the tip of the nozzle. The applicator is now ready for use.
- One drop of 50 micro liters will appear for each squeeze of the trigger.
- Place a droplet on the upper surface of a leaf by touching the leaf surface.
- Apply droplet in the Top 2/3 of tree to ensure maximum biological activity.
- Distribute droplets evenly throughout area to be treated.

APPLICATION RATES

- For maximal results the product must be applied at the beginning of the first generation of False Codling Moth or at first observation.
- For False Codling Moth control at the end of the Citrus season the product must be applied sixteen to twenty weeks before the specific harvest date of the orchard.
- The number of drops per hectare is determined by the population pressure of False Codling Moth. Apply product according to the guidelines below.
- Re - Apply the product within 28 days after last application, with a maximum of five applications per season.
- Do not apply the product to flowers or fruit and avoid contamination of fruit.
- The drops should have a spherical shape for optimum biological activity.

It is recommended that traps are used and placed in the top 2/3 of the tree. When the first False Codling Moth males are observed, start applying the first LAST CALL™ F.C.M. treatment. Re-Apply at 28 days intervals, with a maximum of five applications per season.</p> <p>It is advisable not to treat areas smaller than 5 hectares.</p> <p>Apply the product 4 – 5 times per season for optimal control.</p> <p>It is of critical importance to apply a registered insecticide 16 and 8 weeks before harvest on the outside 6 rows, around the treated area to control any larva.</p>
